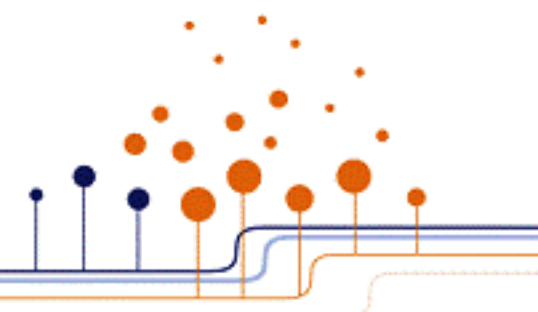

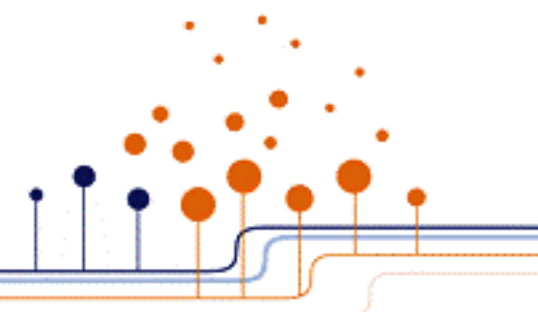


2007-2008 Statistics on the Basis of Annual Policy Report

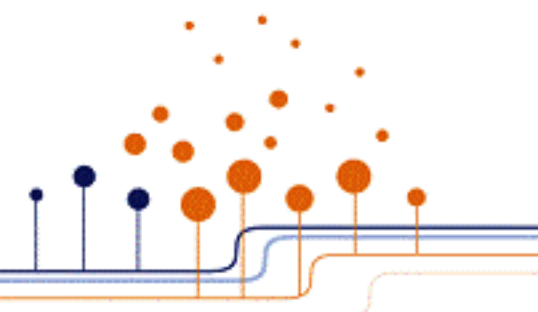

growth



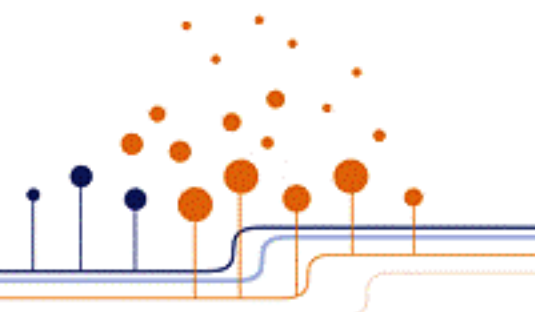
2008 Population – Distribution by Citizenship

2007 statistics: ASYLUM

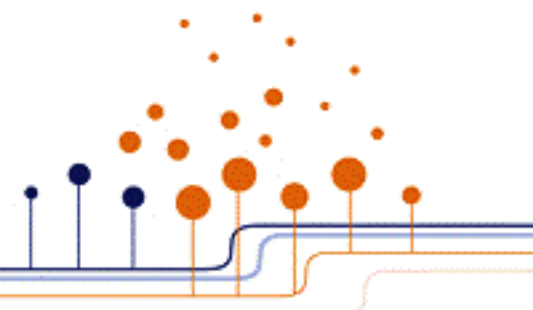
- ✓ In 2007 in total 14 applications for asylum were submitted – 7 Byelorussian, 4 Sri Lankan and 3 Russian citizens.
- ✓ Asylum was granted to two persons and additional protection also to two persons.
- ✓ Two of them were citizens of Sri Lanka, 1 from Russia and 1 from Belorussia.



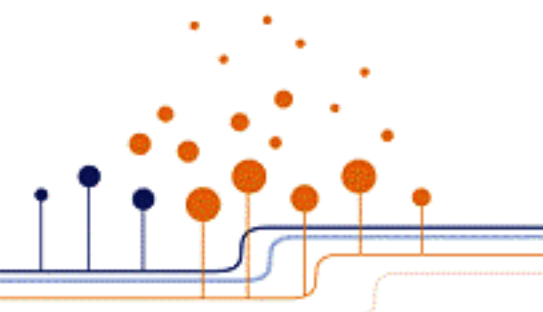
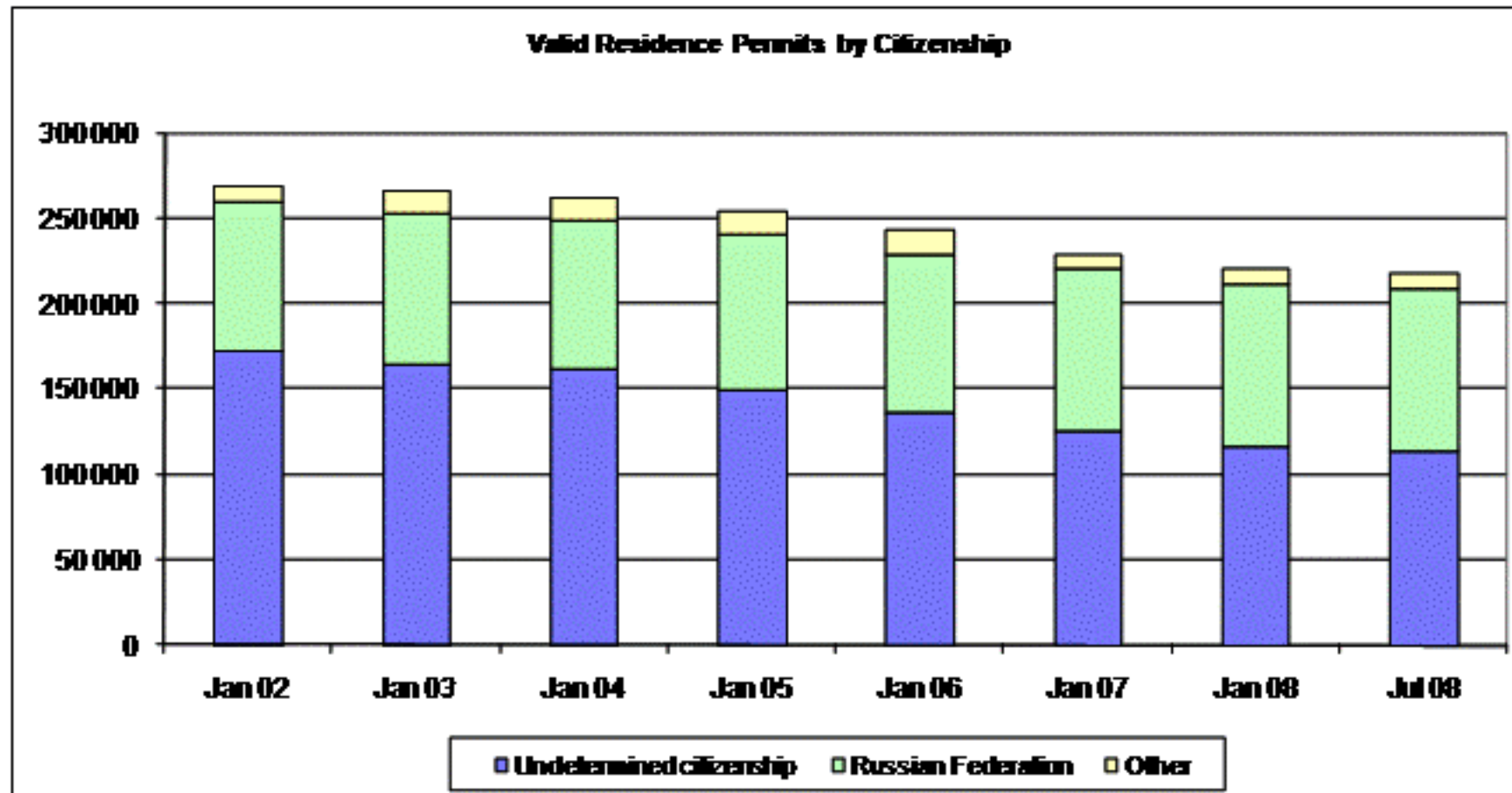
2007 Statistics: Residence Permit

In 2007 **4,235** applications for temporary residence permits and **3,009** applications for extension of the temporary residence permit.

In 2007 there were **3,208** applications for long-term residence permits.

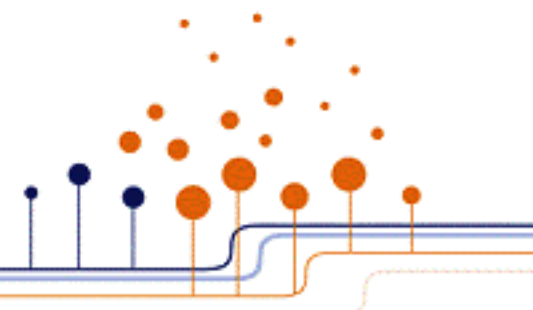


Residence Permits - Distribution by Countries



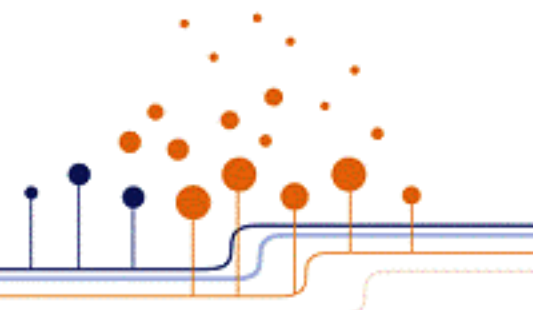
2007 Statistics: Illegal Immigration

- ✓ In 2007 Estonian Board of Boarder Guard identified 41 illegal immigrants and discovered 35 cases of illegal immigration.
- ✓ In 2007 in total 13 persons staying in Estonia illegally were discovered.
- ✓ There were 9 illegal crossings of the border by immigrants.
- ✓ The **total number** of the border crossing from third countries was in 2007 **2 767 657 persons**.



2007 Statistics: Naturalisation

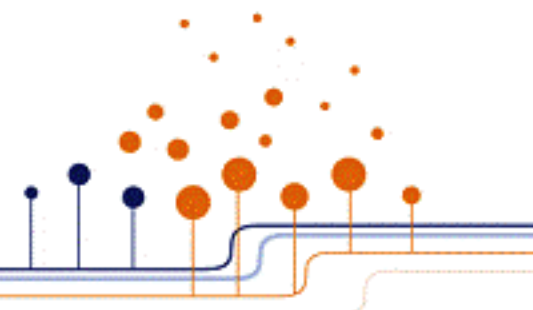
- ✓ Estonian citizenship was given to **4 228** persons, including 294 citizens of other countries, among which again 267 citizens of the Russian Federation.
- ✓ The Government of the Republic refused to give citizenship in 22 cases.
- ✓ For special services, citizenship was given to 4 persons.

Estonian Migration Foundation

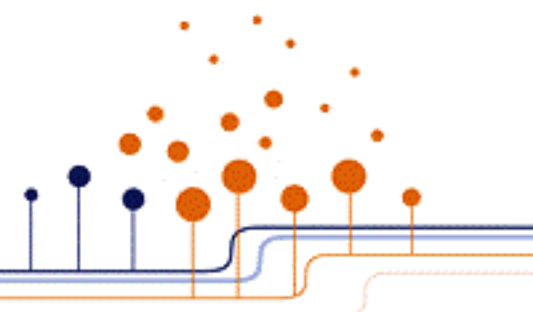
- ✓ Founded in 1992 by the Government of the Republic of Estonia
- ✓ EMF is a legal entity in private law
- ✓ The main purpose is to support the migration and integration processes and to raise funds so as to undertake these tasks
- ✓ The goal of the Migration Foundation is to facilitate the preservation of the Estonian nation and culture



EMF Team

- ✓ 6 persons in the office
 - Head of the Foundation
 - EMN Team – 3 experts
 - Consultant
 - *'Assisted Voluntary Return'* Project Leader

- ✓ 7 members in the Council

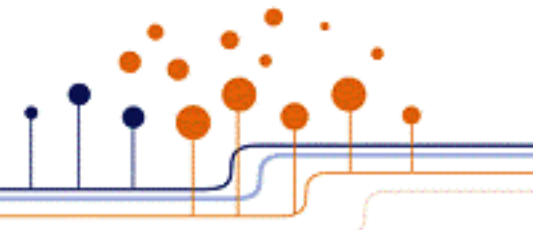


Estonian Migration Foundation as a EMN NCP

- ✓ EMF was appointed as Estonian EMN NCP on **October 06, 2005**
- ✓ 2 experts work full time, 1 Project Coordinator with 0,5 of working load, and 1 Project Supervisor with 0,25 of working load
- ✓ For 2006 and 2008 (second half of the year) activities has received Community grants, covering 80 % of the eligible costs
